**Rules and Guidelines:** Please read and understand.

**Quiet Time:** 11:00pm to 8:00 am. This is strictly enforced for the enjoyment of all guests. No loud music at any time. Respect your neighbours, other campers, their property and privacy.

**Pets:** Pets that are quiet, under control, and on a leash at all times are welcome. All pets **must** be walked outside the park. Pets are not allowed on the beach or playgrounds. Cleaning up after accidents is the responsibility of pet owners. Please make sure children understand these rules, as management has the right to remove unruly pets and their owners at their own discretion.

**Garbage:** Diapers or sanitary napkins can plug sewer system. Place only in garbage containers. Please use dumpster by trailer storage for normal garbage. No cardboard or recyclable materials in dumpster. Please separate your garbage, glass, plastic, newsprint, cans and cardboard into the recycling bins marked with the same. Only household waste allowed in the large garbage bins. No batteries, propane tanks, chairs, etc. Please take your bulk garbage away with yourself.

**Campfires:** For safety reasons, please have a hose handy while having a fire. All fires must be contained in fire pits only and must be extinguished before retiring for the night. Absolutely no garbage is to be burned or left in the fire pits. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult at the firepit.

**Visitors:** There is **no** visitor parking within the park property. If you are expecting visitors, please inform them that they must park outside the property. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

**Boats and Docking:** All boats are to be docked only in their assigned slips. Please stay out of reserved slips. For visitor mooring or if a problem arises, please check with the office or advise managers

**Security:** Do not leave coolers or valuables out at night. Lock vehicles at all times. Do not leave valuables in sight in vehicles. The park is not responsible for any lost or stolen articles/ property.

**Illegal Substances:** No illegal substances are permitted on park property. Any illegal substance found or being used on the property will be cause for immediate termination of stay and removal of you and all your belongings.

**Property Damage:** Any camper or visitor, who willfully or negligently defaces, damages, or destroys property or equipment belonging to the resort, shall be liable for the full replacement value thereof, and will be asked to leave without any refund or compensation.

**Supervision:** All facilities offered or supplied by Tween Lakes Resort are not supervised. Parents are responsible for their children's (any age) actions and activities before and after hours. Please supervise all of your children's activities. Drinking, use of illegal substances, roaming the park after 10:30 pm, disturbing other campers, foul language and bringing in outside guests without permission from management and their parents, will not be tolerated, and will be cause (at manager's discretion) for immediate termination of their stay and removal of all personal property. All younger children must be supervised with an adult while in the washrooms, on the beach, swimming area, as well as to the store.

**Vehicles:** Parking spaces are limited, and therefore we ask that each site only have one vehicle parked. Park is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables left in vehicles.

**Facilities:** Please use facilities at your own risk. Please do not throw cigarette butts on park grounds. We are not responsible for any accidents, mishaps or injuries during your stay at the park. These guidelines have been set out to assist management in making your stay a pleasant experience. If you do not understand anything set forth, please ask. Failure to comply could lead to eviction without reimbursement.
